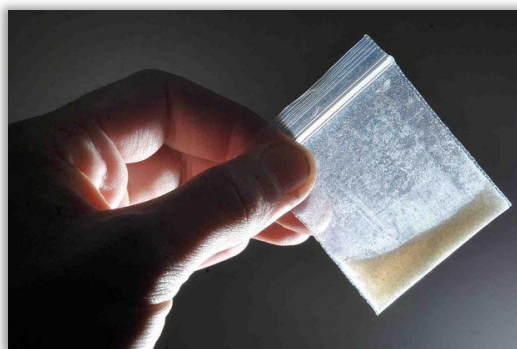


Scenario 1
