Lesson Overview: Class Act



cSTRAND:	Drug and Substance Misuse	Lesson Description: Through an interactive workshop, pupils
KEY STAGE:	KS4	increase their knowledge of the risks, consequences and laws governing substance misuse. They are challenged to take a gamble
LESSON:	Class Act	in an activity that explores the strength, purity and contents of unknown substances and learn about the effects of substance misuse on an individual.

AIM

To raise awareness of the risks of substance misuse and the consequences of possession and supply of illegal substances.
